 graduation They are more inclined to enroll in college

Early College Program Program Design

- ourses may be taken during the fall spring and summer session semesters year long commitment
- ourses available morning afternoons evenings weekends
- ourses meet one or two days per week credits each course
- Students choose which courses to take with guidance from the P campus counselor
- Transportation S transports students to and from the S college for all classes
- ommunication with designated high school counselors and parents guardians is maintained a signed RP waiver is submitted

Early College ProgramApplication Process

- igh School provides copy of the student's grades test scores and immunization records if needed
- pplications due by ebruary in the S uidance ffice
- pplicants create a Suffolk student e mail account as this is the college's mode of communication
- pproved applicants to qualify for enrollment must meet
 mergency Placement uidelines as determined by
 program personnel
- Student transcripts are reviewed and the high school counselor is notified of student's P status
